ONEOK Resources Company and Christopher Gene Bull, d.b.a. Cypress Exploration, sought review of a May 12, 1989, decision of the Muskogee Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, which determined that oil and gas lease No. 601-4905, Martin Daniel, Creek 6739, had expired by its own terms in the absence of production in paying quantities. This case has been stayed since May 2, 1990, in order to allow the parties to pursue settlement.

On June 10, 1991, the Board received a joint motion to dismiss, which stated "that all parties have agreed to a settlement of this matter, and new oil and gas leases covering the tract which is the subject of this case have been approved by the District Court of McIntosh County, Oklahoma."

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, this appeal from the Muskogee Area Director's May 12, 1989, decision is dismissed.
