This is an appeal from a September 25, 1989, decision of the Acting Anadarko Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, denying appellant's application for an Indian Self-Determination Act grant for FY 1989. The parties now state that they have reached settlement and move the Board to dismiss this appeal.
