This appeal concerning the status of the Lytton Indian Community has been pending before the Board since February 1988. It has been stayed for most of the last three years, while settlement was pursued in a related case pending in Federal district court, Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians of the Sugar Bowl Rancheria v. United States, Civil No. C-86-3660 WWS (N.D. Cal.).

Appellant now reports that a stipulated judgment has been entered in Scotts Valley Band which grants appellant the relief it sought in this appeal. Appellant therefore moves this Board to dismiss its appeal.

In accordance with appellant's request, and pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is dismissed.
