On June 29, 1992, the Board of Indian Appeals received a request to reopen the estate of Virgil N. Stricker (decedent). The request was made by Orville Stricker, who states that he is decedent's son.

Under 43 CFR 4.242, a request to reopen an Indian estate must be filed with the Administrative Law Judge who issued the original decision, or with his/her successor. Orville Stricker should submit his request to the appropriate Administrative Law Judge. ^{1/} If the Administrative Law Judge denies his request, he may appeal the denial to this Board.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this matter is dismissed without prejudice.
