This is an appeal from a September 25, 1992, decision of the Acting Anadarko Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, disapproving an amendment to a special counsel contract between the Cheyenne-Arapaho Tribes of Oklahoma and the Native American Rights Fund.
