On January 29, 1993, the Board approved a partial settlement of this appeal. Pursuant to the Board's order, the entire interest of decedent Lena "Belena" Dick (Roberts) Starr in pending Native Allotment F-017160 has vested in appellant Linda Roberts Evans. Also pursuant to that order, all of Starr's interest in Townsite Lot 12, Block 6, U.S. Survey 2754 A & B, Townsite of Tanana, except for the 9/72 interest inherited by Brenda Luke Anderson, has vested in appellant.

The Board's January 29, 1993, order advised appellant that she had the right to continue this appeal as it concerned the 9/72 interest in the townsite lot which did not vest in her pursuant to the order. Appellant was requested to inform the Board by March 15, 1993, whether or not she wished to continue the appeal and was advised that, if she did not so inform the Board, the remainder of the appeal would be dismissed.

Appellant has not informed the Board that she wishes to continue the appeal. Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with respect to the 9/72 interest in Townsite Lot 12, Block 6, U.S. Survey 2754 A & B, Townsite of Tanana, which was inherited by Brenda Luke Anderson. 1/
