Appellant Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe sought review of an April 8, 1994, decision of the Aberdeen Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, disapproving its application for a FY 1994 Planning Grant. The appeal was docketed and a briefing schedule was established by order dated June 16, 1994.

Later on June 16, 1994, the Board of Indian Appeals received a letter from appellant informing it of appellant's decision not to appeal the decision. The Board considers this letter to be notice of appellant's withdrawal of its appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.10, this appeal from the Aberdeen Area Director's April 8, 1994, decision is dismissed with prejudice.
