This is an appeal from a June 22, 1994, decision of the Portland Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to take a 12.42-acre tract of land in North Bend, Oregon, into trust for the Coquille Tribe. The appeal has been consolidated with another appeal from the same decision filed by the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua, and Suislaw Indians, Docket No. IBIA 94-168-A.

On October 31, 1994, the Board received notice from appellant City of North Bend that it was withdrawing its appeal.

This appeal is severed from Docket No. IBIA 94-168-A. Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, it is dismissed with prejudice.
