On November 28, 1994, the Board received a notice of appeal from the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua, and Siuslaw Indians, through counsel, Dennis J. Whittlesey, Esq., Washington, D.C. Appellant seeks review of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) issued by the Acting Superintendent, Siletz Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs, on October 24, 1994. The FONSI concerns a proposed business lease of a 12.42 acre tract by the Coquille Indian Tribe to the Coquille Economic Development Corporation.

The Board does not have jurisdiction to review decisions of BIA Superintendents. Instead, Superintendents' decisions must be appealed to the appropriate Area Director. See 25 CFR 2.4(a); 43 CFR 4.331(a). In this case, that is the Portland Area Director.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is docketed and dismissed as premature.
