This is an appeal from an August 29, 1994, decision of the Juneau Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, declining to award attorney fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), in connection with a decision concerning an Indian Self-Determination Act contract.

On November 7, 1994, the Board stayed proceedings in this matter under 43 CFR 4.611(a), because there had not been a final disposition of the underlying dispute.

On July 31, 1995, the Board received a status report from appellant, stating that it has chosen not to pursue its EAJA appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is dismissed.
