Appellant Bank of Hoven sought review of an October 31, 1995, decision issued by the Acting Aberdeen Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Area Director). The Area Director reduced appellant's claim for loss on a loan to Glen and Kathy Cudmore. On March 7, 1996, the Board of Indian Appeals received a letter from appellant stating that it was dropping its appeal.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal from the Acting Aberdeen Area Director's October 31, 1995, decision is dismissed with prejudice.
