This is an appeal concerning the Bureau of Indian Affairs, failure to credit interest on the Hoopa Valley Tribe's investments 77451 and 77429. The appeal was brought under 25 CFR 2.8 and alleged that BIA had failed to act despite requests made pursuant to that section.

Proceedings have been stayed since June 22, 1995, to enable the parties to pursue settlement.

On March 19, 1996, the Board received the parties' settlement agreement and stipulation for dismissal with prejudice. On March 25, 1996, the Board received notice from counsel for the Acting Director, Office of Trust Funds Management, that payment had been made to appellant in accordance with the settlement agreement.

Therefore, in accordance with the parties' request, and pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 CFR 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
