Appellant California Indian Legal Services sought review under 25 C.F.R. § 23.13 of the failure of the Sacramento Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), to respond to its request for payment of attorney fees in regard to the proceeding In re Guardianship of Dominic and Isaac Antone, Sonoma County, California, Superior Court, Case Nos. 68001 and 68002. Although BIA did not dispute that payment was due, there was apparently a disagreement over what division or branch of BIA would be responsible for making payment.

On January 19, 1999, the Board received notification from Appellant that it had received payment on January 4, 1999. Appellant requested that its appeal be dismissed.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, and the request of the Appellant, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
