The Board dismissed this appeal on January 11, 1999. 33 IBIA 101. Appellant has filed a petition for reconsideration.

Under 43 C.F.R. § 4.315(a), a petition for reconsideration of a Board decision “must be filed with the Board within 30 days from the date of the decision.” Appellant’s petition for reconsideration is postmarked February 18, 1999, more than 30 days after January 11, 1999. Accordingly, the petition is untimely.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, Appellant’s petition for reconsideration is denied as untimely.
