Appellant States, Inc., sought review of a September 14, 1999, decision of the Southern Plains Regional Director (formerly the Anadarko Area Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning the alleged expiration of Oil and Gas Lease No. 14-20-205-7613, covering Cheyenne-Arapaho Allotment No. 3057, Elk Road, for failure to produce oil and/or gas in paying quantities. On November 5, 1999, the Board received notification that Appellant was withdrawing its appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
