This is an appeal from a January 22, 1999, decision of the Acting Director, Office of Economic Development, Bureau of Indian Affairs, denying a request for payment on defaulted loans made to James R. Wilson. Proceedings have been stayed since October 6, 1999, in order to permit the parties to negotiate a settlement agreement.

On June 12, 2000, Appellant filed a motion to dismiss this appeal.
