These are appeals from September 8, 2000, decisions of the Acting Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director), assessing amounts for past use and occupancy of a portion of Nez Perce Allotment 1417. The Board issued a pre-docketing notice on October 6, 2000.

The Regional Director has filed a request for remand of these cases. He states that the assessments in both decisions were erroneous and that, upon remand, he would issue new decisions stating the correct amounts.

In accordance with the Regional Director's request, and pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, these appeals are docketed, the Regional Director's September 8, 2000, decisions are vacated, and these cases are remanded to him.

If Appellants disagree with the amounts assessed in the Regional Director's new decisions, they may appeal those decisions to the Board.
