Appellant Snohomish County, Washington, sought review of a December 18, 2000, decision of the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning taking a 16-acre tract of land, known as the "Riverside Property," into trust status for the Stillaguamish Tribe of Indians. The tract is located in sec. 6, T. 31 N., R. 5 E., W.M., Snohomish County, Washington.

On March 30, 2001, the Board received a letter from Appellant stating that it had reached an agreement with the Tribe and that it was therefore withdrawing its appeal.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed on the basis of the agreement reached by the parties.
