Appellant State of Oregon sought review of a December 1999 decision of the Acting Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning taking Tax Lots 900 and 1000, Map 30-5-07C, located in sec. 7, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, into trust for the Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians. This matter has been stayed while the parties discussed settlement.

On April 2, 2001, the Board received a letter from Appellant indicating that the settlement discussions were successful and that it was withdrawing its appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal from the Acting Northwest Regional Director's decision is dismissed on the basis of the settlement reached between the parties.
