Appellant Iowa Tribe of Oklahoma sought review of a March 23, 1999, decision of the Anadarko Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Area Director), declining a contract proposal for Anadarko Area Office Tribal Shares for fiscal year 1999 under the Indian Self-Determination Act, 25 USC §§ 450-450n. By order dated March 12, 2001, the Board of Indian Appeals asked the parties whether this case was moot. Both Appellant and the Area Director have responded that the appeal is moot.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed as moot.
