Appellant Charles Lukin sought review of a December 15, 2000, decision issued by the Rocky Mountain Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director). The decision concerned alleged delinquent irrigation operation and maintenance charges in regard to the Blackfeet Irrigation Project. On April 19, 2001, the Regional Director asked the Board to vacate his decision and remand this matter to him so that he could consider additional information now available to him. The Regional Director states that he has contacted Appellant and that Appellant does not oppose the motion.

The Regional Director's motion is granted.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Regional Director's December 15, 2000, decision is vacated and this matter is remanded to the Regional Director for further consideration.
