Appellant Salt River Pima-Maricopa Indian Community sought review of a May 29, 2001, decision issued by the Western Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, concerning a negotiated development lease between the owners of ten allotments on the Salt River Indian Reservation and Apex Park at Pima, LLC. On August 2, 2001, the Board of Indian Appeals received a motion from Appellant seeking to withdraw its appeal.

The motion is granted.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is dismissed with prejudice.
