Gordon W. Stump (Appellant) has filed a notice of appeal from an August 2, 2002, Order Denying Reopening issued by Administrative Law Judge Robert G. Holt in the estate of Eleanor Hubbard Stump Saddler. IP TC 244 R 96.

Under 43 C.F.R. § 4.320(a), Appellant was required to file his notice of appeal within 60 days from the date of Judge Holt's decision. Appellant's notice of appeal is dated October 23, 2002, and postmarked October 25, 2002, more than 60 days after the date of Judge Holt's decision.
