Appellants Carmen Abraham and Nasbah Greeyes sought review of an August 20, 2003, decision of the Acting Great Plains Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director; BIA), concerning the approval of gift deeds from Heather Abraham to Laureen Jetty by the Fort Totten Agency, BIA. For the reason below, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) docketed, but dismisses this appeal.

In its September 23, 2003, pre-docketing notice and order to show cause, the Board gave Appellants until November 14, 2003, to show that they have standing to bring this appeal in light of the Board's decisions in Mechelen v. Acting Portland Area Director, 34 IBIA 202 (2000), and Chehalis Tribe v. Portland Area Director, 34 IBIA 100 (1999). The Board has received no response from Appellants.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, this appeal is docketed, but dismissed for failure to prosecute.
