Appellants Pat Chee Miller and Loretta A. Miller appealed from a July 23, 2004, decision of the Navajo Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director), giving notice of the expiration of Use Permit No. N00-C-1420-4647, issued for their mobile home park, Teec Soos Estates, in Crownpoint, New Mexico. The land covered by the permit is more specifically described as 4.918 acres (+/-) of lands withdrawn by Executive Order 1359, within Section 30, Township 17 North, Range 12 West, N.M.P.M., McKinley County, New Mexico.

On October 13, 2005, the Board received a request from Appellants to withdraw their appeal. The request states that Appellants have closed Teec Soos Estates and have vacated the property.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board grants Appellant's request and dismisses this appeal.
