On October 3, 2005, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a notice of appeal from the Town of Montville, Connecticut (Town), seeking review of a September 15, 2005, decision of the Eastern Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, which approved a request from the Mohegan Tribe of Connecticut (Tribe) for the United States to acquire 24 tracts of land in New London County, Connecticut, in trust for the Tribe.

On October 11, 2005, while this appeal was still in the pre-docketing stage, the Board received from the Town a “formal notice that the appeal is withdrawn.”

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed and dismisses this appeal.
