On October 3, 2005, the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) received a notice of appeal from Jack Bickel, on behalf of himself, Judy Bickel, and Keith Bickel (Appellants), seeking review of an August 31, 2005 decision of the Great Plains Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director). The Regional Director’s decision established a new reservation minimum grazing rental rate of \$10.50 per Animal Unit Month for individually owned Indian lands on the Standing Rock Sioux Reservation for the new permit period beginning November 1, 2005, pursuant to 25 C.F.R. § 166.400.

The notice of appeal was not signed, and on October 5, 2005, the Board ordered Appellants, on or before October 28, 2005, to file with the Board the notice of appeal with their signatures. The Board’s order stated that “[f]ailure to comply with this order may result in summary dismissal of this appeal without further notice.” (Emphasis in original.)

The Board has received no response from Appellants.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.
