Appellant Genevieve Eklund (Crebassa), pro se, appealed from a July 7, 2006 Order Denying Petition for Reopening entered by Administrative Law Judge Richard J. Hough in the estate of Harry J. Crebassa (Decedent), deceased L'Anse Indian, Probate No. TC 494S-91. The Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.

Appellant's notice of appeal did not indicate she had served copies of her notice of appeal on Judge Hough and on all interested parties, as required by 43 C.F.R. § 4.320(c). On August 2, 2006, the Board issued an order requiring Appellant, on or before August 18, 2006, to complete these service requirements and to file a statement with the Board that she had done so. The order advised Appellant that failure to respond could result in summary dismissal of the appeal without further notice.

The Board has received no response from Appellant.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute. 1/
