Dixie Byrd (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an October 3, 2006, decision of the Acting Great Plains Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director), concerning the removal of trust land in which Appellant owns an interest from Range Unit 202 on the Cheyenne River Reservation.<sup>1</sup>

On July 31, 2007, the Board received a motion from Appellant, unopposed by the Regional Director, to dismiss her appeal.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board grants Appellant's motion and dismisses this appeal.
