The Board of Indian Appeals (Board) dismissed this appeal by Appellant Michael H. Moran on April 16, 2007. 44 IBIA 245. On May 10, 2007, it denied a petition for reconsideration filed by Appellant. 45 IBIA 26. On October 31, 2007, the Board received a letter from Appellant, again expressing disagreement with the Board’s decision. The Board construes Appellant’s letter as a second petition for reconsideration.

The Board’s regulations provide: “A party may file only one petition for reconsideration.” 43 C.F.R. § 4.315(b). Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, Appellant’s second petition for reconsideration is dismissed.
