The Northwest Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), forwarded to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) a notice of appeal from Mr. and Mrs. Donald Logan, Elise Johnson, Elizabeth Knowles, and Michelle Bauchman (Appellants), which the Board received on July 31, 2008. Appellants, *pro se*, seek review of a June 17, 2008, decision of the Regional Director, which modified the November 2, 2007, decision of the Puget Sound Agency Superintendent, BIA, to adjust the annual rental on Lease No. 8595 01-51 to \$9,000 for Lot 2 of Ray Paul Waterfront tracts, located on the Swinomish Reservation.

On August 6, 2008, the Board ordered Appellants to show cause why their appeal should not be dismissed as untimely. The Board advised Appellants that failure to comply with the order could result in dismissal of their appeal without further notice.

Appellants' response to the Board's order was due on or before August 29, 2008. The Board has received no communication from Appellants.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed this appeal, but dismisses it for failure to prosecute.
