Klamath County, Oregon, Board of Commissioners (County), appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from five decisions of the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, each dated October 27, 2008, in which the Regional Director determined to take six tracts of land into trust on behalf of the Klamath Tribe of Oregon.¹ By order of January 21, 2009, the Board consolidated the above appeals and issued a briefing schedule.

On February 17, 2008, the Board received a notice of withdrawal of its appeals from the County.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses these consolidated appeals.
