Appellant Adeline Black appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a May 1, 2008, decision of the Acting Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director; BIA), in which he affirmed the decision of the Acting Superintendent of the Puget Sound Agency, BIA, to adjust the rent for Lease No. 8631 02-27, covering Lot 21, Division 1 of the Dr. Joe Waterfront Tracts within Gov't Lot 2, Section 3, T. 33 N., R. 2 E., Willamette Meridian, Skagit County, Washington, on the Swinomish Reservation.

On November 3, 2009, the Board received a Joint Withdrawal of Appeal from the parties in which they represent that the appeal has been settled. The parties request that the Board dismiss this appeal from its docket. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts in resolving this dispute.
