The City of San Jacinto, California (City), appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a June 27, 2008, decision of the Acting Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to accept into trust two parcels of land, consisting of 477.65 acres, for the Soboba Band of Luiseno Indians (Tribe).

On January 29, 2010, the Board received a Request for Dismissal from the City in which the City represents that a compromise and settlement have been reached with the Tribe that resolves this appeal. Therefore, the City requests that the Board dismiss this appeal from its docket. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts in resolving this dispute.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
