Appellants Charles L. and Dana D. Heald appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a June 18, 2008, decision of the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director), in which the Regional Director modified the Puget Sound Agency Superintendent's decision to adjust the annual rental, effective April 1, 2007, for Lease No. 8597 02-52, covering Lot 9 of the Doctor Joe Waterfront Tracts, Division II, on the Swinomish Reservation.<sup>1</sup>

On February 5, 2010, the Board received a Notice of Withdrawal from Appellants in which they report that the dispute is resolved and advise the Board that they withdraw their appeal. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts in resolving this dispute.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
