Kootenai County, Idaho (County), appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an April 21, 2010, decision of the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to accept into trust, on behalf of the Coeur d’Alene Tribe, a 142.56-acre tract of land near Plummer, Idaho, known as the “Ramsay Property.”<sup>1</sup>

On July 19, 2010, the Board received a Notice of Withdrawal of Appeal from the County, withdrawing the appeal and requesting dismissal with prejudice.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
