The City of Pilot Point, Alaska, and Knik Construction Co., Inc. (Knik), separately appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a January 25, 2008, decision of the Alaska Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (Regional Director; BIA). The Regional Director terminated a Grant of Easement for Right-of-Way (GOE/ROW) to Knik on Native Allotment No. AA-8276, for non-use and abandonment. BIA had approved the GOE/ROW to Knik on September 1, 1987, for the purpose of a road.

The appeal proceedings have been stayed pending settlement negotiations among the parties. On September 17, 2010, the Board received a Request for Dismissal from Appellants and the Regional Director, stating that the parties have reached a settlement and requesting that the Board dismiss this appeal. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts in resolving this dispute.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
