Farrel C. Reevis (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an October 28, 2010, decision of the Rocky Mountain Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), upholding a decision by the BIA Blackfeet Agency Superintendent declining to approve an owner's use/negotiated grazing permit for Appellant for Range Unit 608 on the Blackfeet Reservation. The Superintendent declined to approve the permit on the ground that Appellant had two delinquent grazing rental invoices.

On January 12, 2011, the Board received a letter from Appellant withdrawing his appeal because the dispute with BIA has been resolved. The Board appreciates the parties' successful efforts in resolving this dispute.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed but dismisses this appeal.
