Michael Mitchell (Appellant) sought review from the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) of an August 18, 2011, decision of the Acting Northwest Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), that affirmed a decision by BIA's Puget Sound Agency Superintendent to adjust the annual rent for Lease No. 123 2085880126 HS, covering Lots 90 and 91, Block 1, of the Hermosa Point Summer Home Sites on the Tulalip Reservation.

On October 6, 2011, the Board received a request from the Regional Director to vacate his decision, dismiss the appeal, and remand this matter to him for further action and review.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Regional Director's August 18, 2011, decision is vacated, Appellant's appeal is dismissed, and this matter is remanded to the Regional Director for further action and review.
