Spencer (Appellant) sought review from the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) of a July 18, 2011, decision of the Acting Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), affirming the decision of the Acting Superintendent of BIA’s Puget Sound Agency to adjust Appellant’s annual rent for Lease Number 122 2085680158, covering Lot 3 of the Morris Dan Waterfront Tracts on the Swinomish Reservation in Washington.
