Scott County, Minnesota (County) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from three decisions, dated August 20, August 24, and August 31, 2012, of the Midwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to approve the acceptance into trust of properties located in the County by the United States for the Shakopee Mdewakanton Sioux Community of Minnesota, referred to as the “Shutrop property” (F-411-2011-2555), “Stemmer property” (F-411-2011-2568), and “Wozupi property” (F-411-2011-2571).

On October 22, 2012, the Board received from the County a withdrawal of its appeals.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed and dismisses these appeals.
