Michael W. Bowker and Majel Del Rio (Appellants) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from two decisions of the Acting Great Plains Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), involving the ownership of Cheyenne River Tracts X1982 and X1982-A.¹ On January 14, 2013, the Board received statements from Appellants withdrawing their appeals.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses these appeals.

¹ Bowker appealed from a May 29, 2012, decision of the Regional Director, and his appeal was assigned Docket No. IBIA 12-146. Del Rio appealed from a July 30, 2012, decision of the Regional Director, and her appeal was assigned Docket No. IBIA 13-015. Each decision addressed an appeal by each Appellant from a December 6, 2011, decision of BIA's Cheyenne River Agency Superintendent. The Board consolidates the two appeals for purposes of this order of dismissal.
