Shawano County, Wisconsin (County) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an April 27, 2012, decision of the Midwest Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), to approve the acceptance into trust of land located within the County by the United States for the Ho-Chunk Nation of Wisconsin, referred to as the former “Weller” property (F-439-2008-1716).

On January 31, 2013, the Board received from the County a withdrawal of its appeal, conditioned on the County’s understanding that there are no costs or fees associated with withdrawing its appeal. The County’s understanding is correct.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
