The Dehesa Valley Community Council, Inc. (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an October 19, 2012, decision (Decision) by the Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to accept approximately 1411.11 acres of land, located in San Diego County, California, in trust for the Sycuan Band of the Kumeyaay Nation.

On February 1, 2013, the Board received from Appellant a withdrawal of its appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed and dismisses this appeal.<sup>1</sup>
