San Diego Gas & Electric Company (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an October 19, 2012, decision by the Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to accept approximately 1411.11 acres of land, located in San Diego County, California, in trust for the Sycuan Band of the Kumeyaay Nation (Nation).

On February 22, 2013, the Board received a motion from Appellant to dismiss its appeal. Appellant states that it has entered into an agreement with the Nation that is intended to resolve all issues in the appeal. The Board appreciates the parties' efforts to resolve this dispute and grants the motion to dismiss.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
