Fleming D. Begaye and Veronica Walters (Appellants) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an October 1, 2012, decision of the Acting Navajo Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), finding that Appellants failed to timely exercise an option to renew Business Lease No. CH-89-85 with the Navajo Nation, and therefore the lease expired on September 30, 2012.

On March 21, 2013, the Board received a Joint Notice of Settlement and Motion to Dismiss executed by Appellants and BIA. The parties represent that they have reached a settlement agreement that fully resolves the issues in this appeal and that the Navajo Nation does not object to the settlement agreement. Thus, the parties request that this appeal be dismissed with prejudice. The Board extends its appreciation to the parties for their successful efforts in resolving this dispute.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal with prejudice.
