Terrence A. Carroll and Diane M. Carroll (Appellants) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a January 3, 2012, decision of the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), that affirmed a decision by BIA’s Puget Sound Agency Superintendent to increase the annual rent, effective July 1, 2011, for Appellants’ Lease No. 122 2096109656 HS,¹ covering Lot 1C and a portion of Lot 1D of the Doctor Joe Waterfront Tracts on the Swinomish Reservation.

On April 26, 2013, the Board received a “Joint Status Report and Motion to Dismiss Appeal” from the parties in which they advise that this matter has been resolved. The parties now request that the Board dismiss this appeal from its docket. The Board extends its appreciation to the parties for their successful efforts in resolving this dispute.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
