Linda Clingan and Michael Templeton (Appellants) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an April 2, 2013, decision of the Acting Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), which affirmed a November 20, 2012, decision of BIA’s Puget Sound Agency Superintendent adjusting the annual rent for one of Appellants’ residential ground leases on the Swinomish Reservation.¹ On July 2, 2013, the Board received a motion to dismiss the appeal from Appellants, in which they advise that this matter has now been resolved. The Board appreciates the parties’ efforts to resolve this dispute and grants the motion to dismiss.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
