Mark Goad (Appellant), appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a February 27, 2013, decision of the Acting Osage Agency Superintendent (Superintendent), Bureau of Indian Affairs, disapproving the Last Will and Testament, dated December 21, 2003, of Charles Anthony Goad, deceased unallotted Osage.<sup>1</sup> On July 25, 2013, the Board received a motion from Appellant to dismiss the appeal with prejudice. The Board grants the motion.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
