Delbert Wheeler, Sr. (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a July 13, 2012, decision by the Northwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), affirming a January 31, 2012, decision by BIA's Yakama Agency Superintendent, declining to approve the proposed sale of five tribal tracts of land by the Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation to Appellant. On September 9, 2013, the Board received an unopposed motion from Appellant advising the Board that the dispute has been settled and seeking withdrawal of the appeal. The Board appreciates the parties' efforts to resolve the dispute and grants the motion.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
